Welcome to 6th Grade Orchestra!

What do you need to get started in Orchestra?

- You will need to rent an instrument. NOTE: Instruments come in different sizes; be sure to go with your parent or guardian to the music store when you rent your instrument. It is important to get the right fit!
- Rosin for your bow
- Essential Elements Book 1 with EEi for your chosen instrument.
- A 1" hardcover black binder and a pencil
- Cello and Bass players will need an "end pin" holder.
- Violin and Viola players will need a "shoulder rest"

I highly recommend a Kun or Everest shoulder rest as these shoulder rests have the fewest problems for students.

- A **music stand** (purchase at local music store or on Amazon)
- Optional: A chromatic tuner such as Korg or Snark, OR if you have a smart phone, you can get a FREE tuning app on your phone!

Where do I rent an Instrument?

It is a very good idea to <u>rent</u> an instrument before purchasing! Instruments come in different sizes and you are not done growing! Also, there is a huge variety in the quality of string instruments. Inexpensive instruments often create frustration for the student and additional expense in repairs.
